Our judge, the Honorable Ty Irby, is a third generation horseman who owns and operates TWH farms in Mobile, Alabama and Shelbyville, Tn. Ty and his family participate in showing, breeding and raising some of the top performance and flat shod horses in the industry today and are committed to the success of the TWH breed. Ty holds a Master Judge license and has judged most of the major shows across the US over the past 30 years including the Celebration and International. He has a Degree in Business Administration/Finance from the University of South Alabama and owns and operations Ty Irby Realty & Development Co. in Mobile, Alabama.

Entries close July 3. The show closing date not only allows time for the office staff to prepare your entries properly, it also gives us the information needed by the fairgrounds to prepare the stalls. By contract, we must give them the amount of stalls needed 1 week before the show. Please try to get your entries in early.

Exhibitors please note::: The fair management states that all exhibitors camping on the fairgrounds either in RV's, tents or horse trailers (hooked up to electricity or not) MUST PAY THE \$75.00 CAMPING FEE. Someone will be assigned to ensure compliance. Therefore, please note your camping fee on your entry. Sorry, they would not budge from this issue.

All TWH presented for DQP inspection must have saddles removed and braces off prior to being inspected. All winners must unsaddle & remove braces prior to post-show inspection.

The horse show and fairgrounds insurance requires that all dogs must be on a leash AT ALL TIMES. The insurance company insists that we enforce this policy, please comply!!!

The fairgrounds personnel have complained that some people are still smoking in the barns and have stated that they will get the fire marshal next time they witness this....\$500 fine!!

Entry form and payment or signed blank check must be postmarked by the closing date (July 3) or you may be charged a late fee of \$15.00. If you enter a class at the DQP station/gate, you will be charged an additional \$10.00 fee to help compensate for the additional work this causes our officials. If your horse does not go in a class as entered, the class must be paid for unless a scratch

slip is filled out and in the office before the class goes in the ring. No refund for any class when a horse is excused by the DQP.

Persons failing to pay their bill in full or paying with a check that is returned will be assessed a \$30.00 service fee. If not paid promptly, the bill will be turned over to Western International for collection.

No chains on TWH pleasure horses and no double sets of chains on any horse are allowed on the show grounds.

Gate holds will be granted for just cause upon notification of the paddock manager. We realize that some gate holds are necessary but please try to keep them to a minimum.

All classes will be conducted by the rules of the WIWHA/SHOW rulebook and the TWHBEA versatility rulebook. The TWHBEA versatility rulebook will prevail.

All TWH exhibitors must have either a youth, amateur or trainer's card. TWH registration papers are required for viewing or you may send copy (front/back) with entry.

There will be no cross entry between 2 gait and 3 gait championships with same horse/rider combination. To qualify for a championship class, a horse must have been shown and judged in a comparable gait class in its division.

The Pacific Northwest Jamboree show officials, WIWHA and Grays Harbor Fair Grounds will not be responsible for any articles that may be lost, destroyed or stolen, although every precaution will be taken to protect property and exhibitors. The show will not be liable for any injury sustained in any way to exhibitors, employees or spectators.

Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, to cancel entries, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel premiums without claims for damages. One horse classes must be sponsored.

Anyone on USDA suspension will not be allowed to transport horses to the showgrounds or participate in the show in any manner.

There will be highpoint awards for plantation, liteshod, trail pleasure and juvenile. Championship classes will qualify for triple points for this show's high point award. **In honor of a great man who loved the Tennessee Walking Horse, we will once again be presenting the Arnie Arnold Versatility Memorial award to the same horse and rider combination accumulating the most points in either plantation, lite shod or trail pleasure. Please see the attached sign-up sheet for requirements and return with your entry. You must be signed up to participate.**
